BROWSING HISTORY

Delete your cookies and browsing history when you finish using a public computer.

Anyone can access public computers, and you wouldn't want just anyone to have access to your personal information and accounts. Always close all browser tabs and log out of your accounts when you are done using a public computer.



SECURE WEBSITES

Look for web addresses with "https://" or "shttp://" when entering personal information.



PUBLIC WI-FI

Limit the type of business you conduct when connected to a public network.
